

FEEDING YOUR LAWN

Veri-Green Lawn Food offers outstanding performance with continuous nutrient release for up to 3 months. Veri-Green Lawn Food is not affected by excessive rainfall and will usually yield a rich-green color within 7 - 14 days after application, if weather conditions permit. Veri-Green Lawn Food can be used on all grass types. If the lawn is under stress from lack of rainfall or heat, and air temperatures are 85 degrees or higher, do not apply this product, as turf injury may occur.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply Veri-Green Lawn Food spring through fall when grass is actively growing on established lawns. Apply when grass is dry and water thoroughly after applying for best results; however, product does not require watering in. You can re-enter lawn area after product is applied.

Apply uniformly with a lawn spreader using the chart listed. Veri-Green Lawn Food will not burn the lawn when applied as directed. At the recommended rate, this product will apply 3 lb. per 1,000 square feet.

In north Florida, Veri-Green can be applied no more than 2 times per year on Centipede, 3 times per year year on Bahia and Zoysia, 4 times per year on St. Augustine and 5 times per year on Bermuda.

In central Florida, Veri-Green can be applied no more than 3 times per year year on Centipede, 4 times per year year on Bahia and Zoysia, 5 times per year year on St. Augustine and 6 times per year year on Bermuda.

In south Florida, Veri-Green can be applied no more than 3 times per year on Centipede, 4 times per year on Bahia and Zoysia, 6 times per year on St. Augustine and 7 times per year on Bermuda.

CARING FOR YOUR LAWN

Mow grass at $2^{-1}/_2$ to $3^{-1}/_2$ inches. Do not remove more than $^1/_3$ of the grass blade at one time, with a sharp mower blade. Mulch clippings or leave them on the lawn if not wet or clumpy. One inch of water from rainfall and/or watering per week is usually adequate unless drought conditions exist.

SPREADER SETTINGS

The following settings are approximate for applying contents of this package at a suggested rate of 3 pounds per 1,000 square feet. Settings are based on an average walking speed. Reduce setting for slower speed; raise setting for higher speed. Check your spreader on 250 square feet and adjust to apply at the rate of .75 pounds per 250 square feet. Spreader condition, rate of walk, and humidity can all vary the rate of application. Sweep (do not wash) all fertilizer materials from surfaces immediately after application, because certain fertilizer ingredients can cause staining. Wash out spreader after each use and allow it to dry thoroughly. Treat any exposed metal spreader areas with oil to reduce corrosion.



USAGE TIPS



For rectangular lawns

Apply two header strips across each end for a turning area. Then apply back and forth in the longest direction.



For irregular-shaped lawns

Apply a header strip around the entire lawn for a turning area, then apply back and forth.

Note: Each pass should be within 10 feet of each other to ensure an overlap.

- Do not leave spreader open when making turns.
- For best results, do not apply on a

- To determine how much coverage you need, multiply the length of your lawn by its width. This equals your total square footage. Deduct any non-lawn areas (house, gardens, walkways, etc.).
